

5. Ask the homeowner if there are any directions as to what is **NOT TO BE TOUCHED**, i.e. (1) any shrubs or trees that they will be upset about being pruned? (2) if there is lots of trash to be cleaned up outside the house, ask if there is anything that is **NOT TO BE DISCARDED**. (3) Stress to the homeowner that this information will be relayed to your crew and that they don't have to tell the individual volunteers themselves. (And then, of course, **DO IT!**)

6. Ask the homeowner if it is okay for the painters to, (1) use the bathroom, (2) use the phone (minimal, but in case more paint and/or materials are needed), and (3) where the paint can be stored at the house for several days or weeks prior to Paint Day.

Ways to Get More Volunteers

7. Tell the homeowner that your crew is composed of volunteers and that **IF IT'S OKAY**, you may want to ask neighbors to help your crew. Say that we like to ask neighbors to join in for two reasons: (1) we can always use extra workers, and (2) it makes it more of a community event. Ask him/her/them if they would be comfortable with your doing that, and **PLEASE** give them lots of room to say "NO", as we don't want to do anything to make this difficult for them...
8. Somewhat similar to the above question, here is an opportunity for the homeowner to approach prospective volunteers for help if they've ideas of people to ask. This would be totally up to them, and we have a letter that might make it easier. If you would like additional volunteers, ask the homeowner if they'd like the letter. (It's the one that says, "Dear Prospective Volunteer.")
