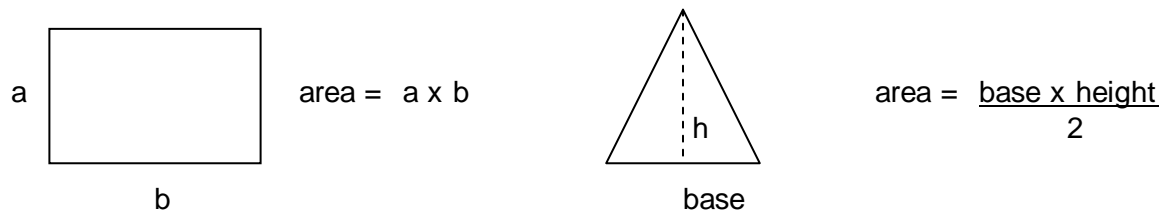




Ordering Paint

The deadline for ordering paint is July 6. Remember to consider porches and painted cement steps and walkways. We suggest 1 gallon for every 250-300 square feet. When figuring out the square footage, be generous and don't deduct the windows and doors. Just add up the square footage of the various surfaces to be painted:



NOTE: We **CANNOT** change the color of a house from light to dark. We've tried it, and that there have been problems: even two coats don't always work.

Stain: Semi-transparent and solid-pigment stains are available.

Custom Tint: If ordering a custom color, we cannot get colors ending in "D" or "N" or "A" because they fade too quickly, and it won't look good sooner than later.

Pick-up: Crew coordinators will be responsible for picking up their primer and paint from Fire Station #2, Tacoma Avenue South and South 27th (in the back), on a date in mid-July (to be announced).

Will-call: If you need **PRIMER** earlier than July 17 (the ESTIMATED date when primer & paint will be available at the Fire Station), let Sallie & Karan know that you need it on a **WILL-CALL**. It will be available at Associated Ministries (Mon-Fri from 9-5; Sat from 10-Noon), 1224 South I St. (corner of So 13th & I Sts, 1 block up the hill from Bates), **but you must call first (1) with an order, and (2) to make an appointment for the pick-up.**

If you need **PAINT** earlier than July 17, let Sallie & Karan know, and we'll put it on a "will-call" at a Parker Paint store near you (they're open Mon-Sat).

NOTE: Paint will be given **ONLY** to crews whose Tech Advisor says there has been contact with the crew coordinator. If the Tech Advisor and crew coordinator(s) haven't met, the paint will be held until we've heard otherwise from the Tech. (This has to do with quality assurance. Thanks for your cooperation.)
